Hope everyone is in good Saata.

As announced earlier, for safety reasons, we will be doing a gradual re-opening of our Temple. The Temple will be open only during the weekends from 10:00 till 12:30 pm. This will allow Pujariji to complete the daily rituals. It will also allow proper cleaning of the temple. Maximum of 4 families will be able to go inside the temple at a time for Darshan only and for maximum of 15 mins.

With everyone's safety in mind, members will be required to practice and comply with the State restrictions, CDC guidelines, and the suggested safety measures mentioned below. If there is any violation, the Committees may have to reconsider the Temple reopening policies. Some of the suggested safety measures are listed below:

- 1) There will be separate entry and exit to the Temple to avoid crossing paths.
- 2) Please wash your hands with soap and water for at least 20 seconds.
- 3) Avoid close contact and maintain at least 6 feet distance with others. The social distancing markers are placed around the Prayer Hall.
- 4) No socializing in temple or in parking lot.
- 5) It is MANDATORY to cover your mouth and nose with cloth face cover/ mask while inside the Temple at all times.
- 6) Members are required to bring their own PPE (Personal Protection Equipment) including mask/cloth face cover and gloves.
- 7) Monitor your health. If you have any symptoms of COVID-19, please stay home and DONOT come to the Temple.
- 8) At a time, only 4 families will be able to go inside the Temple for maximum of 15 min so that other members are able to go in as well.
- 9) Please respect the time inside the temple so that others are not waiting outside.
- 10) Basement, Kitchen remain closed and changing clothes in temple is NOT permitted.
- 11) Members to do walk through darshan ONLY and are NOT permitted to do Abhishek or touch any Bhagwanji, Arti Thali, Ghantaji, chair or any common pooja material.
- 12) Members are not permitted to cross the taped-out areas.
- 13) The security cameras are installed and may be used for surveillance and monitoring.
